Major construction is coming to 84th Ave NE area in June

Plan ahead for NE 28th St and 84th Ave NE closures during roundabout construction

Local drivers should prepare for two multi-day closures of Northeast 28th Street and 84th Avenue Northeast, respectively, as construction crews complete the new 84th Avenue Northeast roundabout. The closures are tentatively scheduled to occur in June and the roundabout will be operational following the two stages, with full details on the next page. Local access will be maintained across SR 520 throughout construction.

How to use the new 84th Avenue Northeast roundabout

The new 84th Avenue Northeast roundabout interchange will have two lanes for general purpose and carpool drivers to reach SR 520 and local destinations, local pedestrian pathways, and connections to the new regional bicycle and pedestrian path.

Drivers

- Advance signage will direct drivers to their destinations
- Lane markings will direct carpools to the on-ramp to westbound SR 520
- Drivers entering the roundabout will yield to vehicles already in it

Pedestrians and bicyclists

- Dedicated pathways and marked street crossings provide access around the roundabout and across the lid
- Pedestrians and bicyclists can connect to the new regional path, which crosses underneath 84th Avenue Northeast

84th Avenue Northeast final design artist rendering






Local and emergency access

- Local access to Medina Circle, Hawthorn Court and Union 76 gas station maintained throughout both phases
- Access for pedestrians, bicyclists, and emergency services maintained throughout both phases

Upcoming outreach

Roundabout construction planning is currently being finalized. Outreach, detours and signage will be implemented in consultation with local jurisdictions to ensure the transition to the final roundabout will be a success.
