

Construction impacts are coming to 92nd Avenue Northeast

Plan ahead for traffic impacts and revisions during roundabout construction.

Over the next few months crews will construct the 92nd Avenue Northeast roundabout in stages, which will require multiple traffic shifts in order to complete the circular structure and the roadways approaching the roundabout.

Due to the current alignment of 92nd Avenue Northeast, traffic impacts will occur during the staging process. Project staff will inform residents prior to the start of construction and keep them informed of their route in and out of their community. Crews will open the 92nd Avenue Northeast lid and roundabout in its final configuration in summer 2014.

Crews will adjust the traffic and pedestrian routes on 92nd Avenue Northeast in order to complete the new configuration. The roundabout will be built in phases, beginning with the area that is out of current traffic. Crews will then implement a series of roadway closures and detours to complete the rest of the phases. During each phase, traffic and pedestrians will have access to and from Yarrow Point via a detour.

Following the opening of the roundabout, crews will continue working on the lid to complete landscaping and the pedestrian paths. See the back of this fact sheet for staging and schedule information.


92nd Avenue Northeast roundabout construction phasing

March 2014

Crews are ramping up 92nd Ave NE roundabout construction beginning mid-March. Please plan for changes to the traffic alignment on 92nd Ave NE and possible short delays through the summer as crews complete the roundabout.


- Site preparation begins mid-March. Crews will clear the landscaping on the north side of the 92nd Ave NE lid.
- Stage 1 is the current roadway alignment on 92nd Ave NE that will be in place through mid-April. During this time, work will progress on the pedestrian tunnel, permanent ramps and roundabout.
- Stage 2 requires a weekend closure in April of the eastbound SR 520 on-ramp and the westbound SR 520 off-ramp to 92nd Ave NE. Expect short delays as traffic will alternate in a single lane over the lid during this weekend. After the weekend, crews will open the permanent westbound SR 520 off-ramp.

STAGE 3 (April - May)




Stage 3 includes a six week closure in April and May of NE Points Drive for crews to build the northeast section of the roundabout. During this time, residents located on NE Points Drive will access their homes via Bellevue Way through the new gate near 96th Ave NE.

STAGE 4 (June)




Stage 4 includes a one month traffic reconfiguration in June. Traffic will be shifted onto the completed portion of the roundabout and pedestrian access will be shifted to the east side of the lid. This traffic reconfiguration allows crews to access and build the northwest portion of the roundabout. Residents on NE 33rd Street will have access to their homes during this stage.

STAGE 5 (July)



Stage 5 is the final stage of roundabout construction. This stage will take place after the July 4th holiday and last for three weeks as crews complete the curb and roadway. During this stage, crews will close a portion of 92nd Ave NE south of the lid between the on-ramp to eastbound SR 520 and NE Points Drive. This closure will last about one week in July as crews complete the roadway expansion in this area. During this week-long closure, residents will be able to access their homes through the construction area. Residents living on the Point will access their homes via SR 520 using the westbound and eastbound ramps. Residents on NE 33rd Street will have access to their homes via single lane of alternating traffic. Pedestrians will have access across the lid during this entire stage.
