

TRIP PERMIT

Descriptions: This permit provides temporary licensing for a vehicle for three consecutive days. The licensed gross weight may not exceed 40,000lbs for a single unit vehicle with three or more axles 80,000 lbs for a combination of vehicles. A vehicle cannot be issued more than 3 trip permits in a 30 day period. Trip permits cannot be used in lieu of tonnage for a vehicle currently licensed in Washington.


Issuing a Trip permit

- Select the vehicle that the permit is for from the Issue Permits screen.

****User can also search for vehicle by Plate, VIN or Unit number.**

- Select Trip permit or type the "t" key and trip permit will populate the Select Permit field.
- Click the [Proceed](#) link to move to the next screen.
- The user has the option to click the **[Multiple Vehicle]** button to select several vehicles at once or **selecting only one vehicle** from the drop down.

The permit must have a start date to validate the permit. The user can click on the calendar that is next to the Start Date field and select the date they want.



User must select if they are Motor Carrier or Non Motor Carrier.

NOTE: If you are any of the following you are a motor carrier

- Vehicle(s) combination GVW of 26,000lbs
- Trailer GVW greater than 10,000lbs
- Carries 16 or more passengers, including driver

At this point it would be a good idea to double check the information for the permit.
